❖ LOCATION OF THE COLLEGE :

The college is exactly situated at Satsia village, ½ Km. distance from Poravita Bazar. About 10 Km. East from Fakirganj Police Station, the college is about 12 Km. distance in the North West Pole from Tikrikilla Bazar (Meghalaya), about 25 Km. distance in the West-North Pole from Lakhipur Town.

❖ ADMISSION PROCEDURE :

Selected Students shall have to present themselves before the admission committee as per dates and times to be notified by the college authority. No application will be considered as valid unless it is accompanied by the attested copies of necessary testimonials (Marksheet, Certificates, Photograph etc.). The applicants are asked to produce the original testimonials at the time of admission. No laminated original marksheets be allowed. The admission schedule will be notified in due time.

❖ ADMISSION RULE :-**A. FREE ADMISSION PROCESS :**

Category of students eligible under free admission.

1. Students whose parental annual income is less than 2.00 Lak from all sources will be eligible to avail free admission.

2. If either of the parent (mother or father) of the student is working in the State Govt./ Central Govt. / Semi Govt. or State or Central Govt. Undertakings, such students shall not be eligible under this scheme.
3. **Proof of income / Documents required :**
- (i) An income certificate from the Local Revenue Circle Officer / Ration Card.
 - (ii) A declaration from the students that neither of the parent (father or mother) of the student is an employee of State / Central Govt. Department or its Undertaking. Such form shall be devised by the principal of Hamidabad College, Satsia. If such a declaration is found to be false, the admission shall be cancelled and fee shall be realized from such students.

N.B. : Free admission will depend on Govt. decision otherwise students have to pay admission fees either free or pay fees structure will be notified later on.

4. **Powers of Admission Committee :**
The admission committee of Hamidabad college, Satsia shall have the power to enquire into the income of the family in case of doubt in regard to students and if the committee is of the view that the income of the parent exceeds Rs. 1.00 Lakh, the committee may recommend cancellation of admission notwithstanding documents submitted by the student. Such enquiry may commence Suo moto lay in Hamidabad College, Satsia or on a complaint received against any student availing benefit under this scheme.
5. **Duties and Responsibilities of students availing the scheme :-**
Students seeking admission into 1st year will plant a sapling at his / her College or, at his/her home and shall give photograph of the same with the student to the college along with the filled up form. The student has to nurse the sapling and while seeking admission into second year shall give photograph of the same tree with the student that was planted during previous year. The scrutiny committee shall be constituted comprising teachers from Biology background who shall examine the photographs and will assess the genuinness of the photographs and growth of the plant. Only on receipt of recommendation from the committee, the student can avail 2nd year fee waiver. This will be effective from the session 2018 (applicable to those who benefitted under the scheme during 2017 session) Students availing the second year fee waiver benefit during the current year will also plant a tree and will nourish it and submit photograph of the same while availing fee waiver benefit subsequently.

- B. All the conditions mentioned in "A" are mandatory for the BA 2nd Yr. students those students availed free admission in the last year but they have to pay only the Magazine, Game & Sports and Uniform fees notified by the authority latter on.
- C. Student seeking admission into BA 3rd Yr. (5th Sem) will have to pay all admision fee.

RESERVATION OF SEATS :

In the matter of admission reservation of the seat (Quota) will be followed as per the rules and regulations framed by the Govt. of Assam and Guwahati University.

LIBRARY FACILITIES :

Library facilities are available like books, journals, news paper, reading room etc.

ATTENDANCE RULE :

Students must attend atleast 75% of classes held during a session. Students attending less than 75% of classes shall not be allowed to appear in the G.U.Examination as per guidelines of Gauhati University.

UNIFORM :

The students of the college must be in Uniform in the college premises during the college hours and various occassions otherwise they will not be allowed to enter into the college premises.

Key Points of Semester System

1. A student will get maximum three chances to clear a particular semester. Three chances means three continuous examinations of a particular semester irrespective of a student appears or not. For example, a student of 2014 batch will get three chances i.e. in 2014, 2015 and 2016, thus, the student shall have to complete his/her all papers of 1st Semester Examination in 2016.
2. Students can apply for repeat examination in one of the theory papers in 1st, 2nd and 3rd Semester examination. The provision for repeat examination is not applicable for 4th, 5th and 6th Semester examination.
3. Re-evaluation of answer scripts should be addressed to the Deputy Controller of Examination, GU through the Principal within 15 days from the date of declaration of results of the respective examination.
4. Students passing in any paper(s) of a semester need to appear in the remaining paper (Failed or not appeared) in the next examination. Students passing in practical paper(s) of a subject need to appear only in theory paper(s) in the subsequent examination.
5. It is mandatory for all the students to appear in Sessional Examinations. The minimum mark for passing in each paper is 30% of the total marks.

6. Subject correction and switch over cases from Major to General course is allowed in 1st semester only. Students applying for switch over from major to general course need to send the information immediately before the examination form fill up.
7. Application Form for Name Correction, Withheld Result Clearance, Subject Correction, Duplicate Grade Sheet / Mark Sheet, Admit Card, Re-evaluation of Answer Scripts etc. may be downloaded from GU Website (www.gauhati.ac.in) and to be submitted to the principal of the respective colleges along with necessary documents and fees.
8. Date of Examination Form fill up and Examination schedule of all semesters to be displayed separately well in advance.
